RULES FOR ADMISSION INTO THE CUTTACK TRAINING COLLEGE.

SESSION, 1937-38.

1. Applications are invited from candidates for admission into the Cuttack Training College for the session 1937-38.

2. The college prepares students for the Diploma-in-Education Examination of the Patna University. A degree of an Indian or any other recognised university is the minimum entrance qualification.

3. Number of admissions is limited to 22. Of these, 2 will be from the Orissa States on the nomination of the Educational Advisor, Eastern States Agency. All applicants must be natives of, or domiciled in, Orissa. Five (5) will receive stipends of Rs. 20 a month each. Each of the other fifteen (15) non-stipendiaries will be provided with a set of text-books not exceeding Rs. 50 in value, which must be returned to the college in good condition, at the end of the session.

4. All applicants shall be required to take a qualifying examination which will be held in the college on the 14th April 1937 at 7 A.M. No admission will be made without a personal interview. Applications from such candidates as are over 31 years may not be considered. Each applicant must send Rs. 5 being caution money and annas four towards charges, etc., for the entrance examination along with his application and obtain from the college office in lieu of the payment of Rs. 5-4-0 his admit card. Without this amount his application will not be accepted and his name will not be enlisted. No candidate will be allowed to sit for the examination unless he has shown his admit card to the presiding officer. In their own interests, candidates are warned to be in possession of admit cards before the date of the examination. Only papers will be supplied to candidates who will sit for the examination.

Candidates are allowed to write out their answers with a pencil or with their fountain pen. The caution money will be forfeited if a candidate fails to join after admission or withdraws at any time during the session. The money will be refunded in case admission is not granted and in case of those who are admitted at the end of the session. A candidate claiming domicile in Orissa, must submit copy of his certificate of domicile along with his application and on admission the original. Degree certificates must be produced by all candidates for inspection by the Principal on the date of admission.

5. If a candidate does not join within a week of his being informed that he has been accepted, his admission will be cancelled and his caution money forfeited.

6. Each selected stipendiary candidate will be required to enter into an agreement in the prescribed form, binding him to complete the course of training to the satisfaction of the Principal and thereafter to serve either as a teacher in a Government school or as a Sub-Inspector of Schools. If he withdraws before completing the course he will have to refund the stipend drawn by him. No permission will be given to candidates admitted for private tuition and study of law during the course of training.

7. Such candidates as do not belong to the University of Patna and graduated from any other university, must also pay at the time of admission, the registration and migration fees levied by and payable to both the universities.

8. All college charges must be paid at the time of admission, viz., the game fee and the common room fee which are respectively Rs. 3 and Rs. 2 for the session.

9. In applying for admission, candidates should supply the following particulars:—

- (a) Candidate's name in full.
- (b) Qualification.
- (c) Father's name.
- (d) Native place (village or town, post office and district).
- (e) Whether native or domiciled.
- (f) Particulars of teaching experience if any.
- (g) Games played; special skill, if any, e.g., music, photography, scouting, painting, etc.
- (h) Subjects studied for (i) degree and (ii) Intermediate examination.
- (i) How the candidate has spent his time since he took his degree.
- (j) If a graduate of another university whether necessary permission to join the Patna University has been received from the Registrar.
- (k) Testimonial, if any, from the principal of the college at which he last studied.
- (l) Whether the candidate is willing to join as a non-stipendiary candidate if he does not qualify for a stipend.
- (m) Age on the 1st July 1937.
- (n) Present address.
- (o) Signature of the candidate with date of application.

RULES FOR ADMISSION INTO THE
CUTTACK TRAINING SCHOOL.

SESSION 1937-39.

Twenty Oriya-speaking stipendiary candidates from the British Orissa and non-stipendiary candidates including 2 candidates from the Orissa States will be admitted to the first year class of the Cuttack Training School on the 1st July 1937. If candidates from the British districts be not forthcoming for the eight non-stipendiary seats which are normally available for them, candidates from the Orissa States may be taken in, to fill up the seats.

2. Only those should apply (a) who are of good physique, of active habits and free from any constitutional defects, (b) who are prepared to take active interest in drill, games, gardening and scouting and (c) who are proficient in Oriya literature. All candidates must be native of, or domiciled in the province of Orissa.

3. The candidates with Matriculation or School-leaving Examination certificates should submit with their applications certified copies of the marks secured by them at the Examination.

4. The length of the course for the Teachers' Certificate is two years. Admission will be confined to the candidates with intermediate qualification, matriculates and holders of the high school-leaving certificates. Preference will be given to those who pass in high divisions provided they satisfy all other conditions.

5. Intending candidates are required to appear at the test examination for admission which will be held in the Training School on the 1st July 1937. They should come provided with writing materials.

6. Students who have passed the Intermediate, Matriculation or School-leaving certificate examination and will reside in the hostel will get a monthly stipend of Rs. 8 only.

7. Before admission into the school the selected candidate will be required (i) to produce his transfer certificate from the institution in which the candidate last read, (ii) to execute an agreement binding him to complete the prescribed course, to abide by the school rules and on completion of the course to serve as a teacher in the province of Orissa for at least three years, if required to do so, and if offered a post of an initial salary of not less than that from time to time prescribed by Government as the minimum pay for teachers of his qualifications in the class of schools concerned. Those who will give up their study before the expiry of their full training period will be liable to refund all the money received by them as advance or stipend.

8. Holders of the Teacher's Certificate are recognised by the department as qualified for any post except headmasterhip of Middle English School for which untrained teachers with intermediate qualifications are eligible, and if appointed to the Vernacular Teachers' Service will draw pay in the following scale or any other scale prescribed by the Government of Orissa:—

- (1) For trained matriculates Rs. 35-1-50 with a selection grade on Rs. 55.
- (2) For trained men with intermediate qualifications Rs. 45-1-50 with the above selection grade.

9. Trained Matrics or S.L.C's are allowed to appear at the I. A. Examination of the Patna University after serving for one year as a teacher in a recognised school of the province.

10. Applications for admission must reach the Headmaster, Cuttack Training School, on or before the 10th May 1937, in the form overleaf containing the full particulars.

RULES FOR ADMISSION INTO THE COMMERCIAL CLASS ATTACHED TO THE
CUTTACK TRAINING SCHOOL FOR THE SESSION 1937-38.

1. The next session of the Commercial class attached to the Cuttack Training School begins from the 1st week of July 1937 and extends over a period of one year.
2. *Subjects taught are.*—Shorthand, Typewriting, Drafting and Book-keeping.
3. The classes are held both in the morning and in the evening.
4. Only Matriculates, School Leaving certificate-holders and candidates with higher qualifications are admitted.
5. Fees are charged at the following rates per mensem :—
