RULES FOR ADMISSION INTO THE CUTTACK TRAINING COLLEGE

SESSION 1944-45

1. Applications are invited from candidates for admission into the Cuttack Training College for the session 1944-45.

2. The College prepares students for the Diploma-in-Education examination of the Utkal University. A degree of an Indian or any other recognised University is the minimum entrance qualification. Those who have appeared or are going to appear at the B. A. or B. Sc. examination whose results are not yet out or will be out later may apply and sit for the qualifying entrance examination. Their admission will depend on the success of their B.A. or B.Sc. examination as well as the results of the entrance examination.

3. Number of admission is limited to 30. All applicants must be natives of or domiciled in the Province. Candidates from the Orissa States who are Oriyas will be admitted on the same basis as Oriya candidates from the Province subject to the existing reservation of two seats for them in the event of less than two candidates qualifying for admission in the competitive examination. They should not, however, be eligible for the bursaries and the books provided by Government at the Training College.

One Oriya student from Singhbhum district will also be admitted into this College but he will not be eligible for bursary and the books provided by the Government as in the case of candidates from States.

Five (5) bursaries each of the value of Rs. 24 a month will be awarded to necessitous students especially to those of the scheduled castes and hill tribes. Candidates must qualify by passing entrance examination which will be a test in general knowledge and intelligence but the bursaries will be awarded definitely on economic grounds.

The system of reservation of bursaries will be as follows:—

- 1 for scheduled castes,
- 1 for hill tribes, and
- 3 open.

Any bursary not awarded to the candidate of the category for which it is reserved will be added to the open class. Women candidates should have a prior claim to the open bursaries. Fifteen sets of text books will be awarded to 15 candidates on payment of a book-fee of Rs. 10 each, which must be returned to the College in good condition at the end of the session.

4. All applicants shall be required to take a qualifying entrance examination which will be held in the College on the 5th May 1944, at 8 A.M. No admission will be made without a personal interview which would take place on the 6th May 1944, at 8 A.M. and on the 7th May 1944, at 8 A.M. if necessary. The age-limit for admission is 31, but preference will be given to younger candidates who are fresh from the colleges. If necessary teachers with shorter period of teaching experience may be taken in. Candidates over 28 years of age are not ordinarily accepted. Each applicant must send Rs. 5 being caution money and annas ten towards charges, etc., for the entrance examination along with his application and obtain from the college office in lieu of the payment of Rs. 5-10-0 his admit card. Without this amount his application will not be accepted and his name will not be enlisted. No candidate will be allowed to sit for the examination unless he has shown his admit card to the presiding officer. In their own interest, candidates are warned to be in possession of admit cards before the date of the examination. Only papers will be supplied to candidates who will sit for the examination. Candidates are allowed to write out their answers with a pencil or with their fountain pen. The caution money will be forfeited if a candidate fails to join after admission or withdraws at any time during the session. The money will be refunded in case of admission is not granted and in case of those who are admitted, at the end of session. A candidate, claiming domicile in Orissa, must submit copy of his certificate of domicile along with his application and on admission the original degree certificates must be produced by all candidates for inspection of the Principal on the date of admission.

5. If a candidate does not join within a week of his being informed that he has been accepted, his admission will be cancelled and his caution money forfeited.

6. Each selected candidate who obtains a bursary will be required to enter into an agreement in the prescribed form, binding him to complete the course of training to the satisfaction of the Principal and hereafter to serve if required to do so either as a teacher in a Government School or in an institution aided by the Government or as an Inspecting Officer in the Education Department for a period of five years from the date of completion of trainings. If he withdraws before completing the course, he will have to refund the bursary drawn by him. No permission will be given to candidates admitted for private tuition and study of Law during the course of training.

7. Such candidates as do not belong to the Utkal University and graduated from any other University must also pay at the time of admission the registration and migration fees* levied by and payable to both the Universities.

8. All College charges must be paid at the time of admission, viz., the game fee, the common-room fee and examination fee which are Rs. 3, Rs. 2 and Rs. 1-7-0 respectively for the session.

9. No fees are charged for tuition and free hostel accommodation is provided for all the students.

10. Attempts will be made to accommodate lady students in the Ravenshaw Girls' School hostel during the session for which previous notice should be given.

EXAMINATION OF COMPOUNDERS AT THE ORISSA MEDICAL SCHOOL, CUTTACK

Notice is hereby given that the next qualifying examination of compounders will be held on the 27th April 1944 at 8 A.M. at the Orissa Medical School, Cuttack, in accordance with Government notification No. 7491-L.S.-G., dated the 25th October 1926.

Every candidate must produce certificates of training, age and previous education as required by rules 7 and 8 of the above notification, published in the *Bihar and Orissa Gazette*, Part II, page 1001, of 3rd November 1926.

Male candidates must submit their certificates and deposit Rs. 5 at the office of the undersigned on the 20th April 1944 between 3 and 4 P.M.

Female candidates will be examined free of charge.

Apprentice compounders trained outside the Province of Orissa are not allowed to sit for the examination.

A Dressership examination will be held on the 28th April 1944 for the students of the compounders' class and no fees will be charged for this optional examination. An outside candidate desiring to appear at the Dresser examination only shall be charged Rs. 2 which will be deposited on the 20th April 1944.

NOTICE

Examination for admission of candidates to the compounder class at the Orissa Medical School, Cuttack, will be held on the 29th April 1944 at 8 A.M., in the school examination hall.

Candidates must be between 17 and 21 years of age.

A qualifying examination in the following subjects is compulsory for those who have not passed the matriculation examination :—

(a) Reading and writing English.

(b) Arithmetic (simple addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, vulgar fraction and rule of three).

The number of seats is limited.

Admission will be restricted to the candidates either natives of or domiciled in the Province of Orissa.

Candidates must submit along with their applications the following documents which will not be returned :—

(a) Certificate of permanent residence, nationality and respectability signed by any Government Officer not below the rank of the Deputy Magistrate or by the Headmaster of the school where the candidate was last educated (bearing a date not earlier than one year from the date of application for admission) or by some authority satisfactory to the Principal.

(b) True copy of domiciled certificate (for domiciled candidates) attested by some gazetted officer.

Selected candidates will be required to produce before the undersigned the transfer certificates from the schools where last studied at the time of their admission in support of their age.

Candidates should apply in the following form between 1st and 15th April 1944 :—

GOVERNMENT SECONDARY AND TRAINING
SCHOOL FOR WOMEN, BERHAMPUR.
TRAINING SECTION

Applications are invited from candidates residing in Orissa who seek admission into the Elementary Training Class of the Government Secondary and Training School for women at Berhampur during the session 1944-45. No candidate who does not possess a working knowledge of Oriya need apply.

2. The course in the elementary training class is for two years. Admissions will be made on the 3rd July, 1944.

3. Candidates who have passed class VII or an examination equivalent thereto are eligible for admission into the elementary training class and those who have passed class V will be placed for a year in the preparatory class before commencing their training. They should pass the middle standard examination in literature and arithmetic before they are admitted into the training class. For admission into the preparatory class candidates should

appear at the test examination to be held in the school on the 3rd July, 1944.

4. Candidates having physical defects or deformities (natural or acquired) are not eligible for admission.

5. Applications in the prescribed form should be made to the Deputy Inspectress of Schools, Ganjam and Koraput districts so as to reach her on or before the 30th April, 1944.

6. Every candidate should submit with her application true copies of (1) General Education Certificate (2) Certificate of conduct and (3) Certificate of domicile if she is not a native of Orissa; and the originals should be produced on admission to the school.

7. Each stipendiary student whether in the training or in the preparatory class will receive a stipend of Rs. 11 a month.

8. Every student selected for training will be on probation for fifty working days and will be required to execute a bond in which she undertakes to pay the cost of her training in addition to the stipends she received while under training, should she fail to serve as a teacher in a recognised school for two years after training.

9. Every student should reside in the hostel, or with her parents or recognised guardian.

10. Each application, if accompanied by an addressed post card, will be acknowledged by the return of the post card with office stamp duly impressed thereon.
