GENERAL SUMMARY.—During the week under report rain fell in all the districts of the Province. The fall was over two inches at Koraput and over one inch at Angul, Bargarh, Berhampur, Nowrangapur and Rayaghada. The threshing of *saradh* paddy still continues in the Puri district. The harvesting and threshing of *dalu* paddy is proceeding in the Cuttack and Puri districts. The pressing of sugarcane continues at places in the Balasore, Puri and Ganjam districts and the planting of the new crop is in progress in the Sambalpur and Koraput districts. The harvesting of tobacco, linseed, *mung*, *mandua*, *china* and *biri* is proceeding. The condition of ragi, gingelly, castor, sugarcane and greengram is fair. The preparation of fields for the next year's crops is in progress. The supply of fodder and water is reported to be sufficient. The average price of local common rice was 17.20 seers a rupee against 17.30 seers in the preceding week in North Orissa and 13.29 seers a rupee against 13.23 seers in the preceding week in South Orissa. The figures for North and South Orissa for the corresponding period of last year are respectively 16.10 and 12.23 seers. Cattle disease is reported from parts of the Puri, Sambalpur and Ganjam districts.
