2. The oral and practical portions of the final examinations of elementary training schools will be held *in situ* at each school within one month prior to the theoretical portion of the examination and will be conducted by the District Inspector concerned or by a trained subordinate inspecting officer under his supervision. Timely notice of the date of the examination at each centre should be given to the private candidates appearing at that centre.

The examination will be held in the following subjects:—

Marks for gardening work done during the year are given by the head teachers and communicated by them to the District Inspector who, after revising them, if necessary, sends them to the School Examination Board.

For the Upper Primary Scholarship Examination questions on Mental Arithmetic for boys will be set under the instructions of the Inspector of Schools of each division and the examination will be conducted by the Superintendent of each centre or by any other body deputed by the Inspector of Schools for that purpose.

3. The results of the practical examination should reach the Registrar on or before the 10th December 1936, positively.

4. The Final Examination of the Elementary Training Schools will be held at centres to be fixed by the Divisional Inspectors of Schools. In fixing these centres Inspectors of Schools are requested to arrange that strict adherence be paid to the rules contained in the Director of Public Instruction, Bihar and Orissa's Circular no. 21, dated the 12th May 1913. The Inspector of Schools will also appoint Superintendents for the aforesaid examinations.

5. The Middle School Certificate and Upper Primary Scholarship Examinations will be held at the headquarters of each district and at such other centres as the Director may approve. Candidates will be informed by the District Inspector, the Deputy Inspector or the District Inspectress who register their names at what place and time they are required to attend. All enquiries regarding the examination should be addressed to the District Inspector or the Deputy Inspector or the District Inspectress as the case may be.

6. There will be a separate Examination Board in each division consisting of the Divisional Inspector of Schools as President, the District Inspectors, the District Inspectresses and the Divisional Examiners as members. These Divisional Boards will be responsible for the entire conduct of the Middle School Certificate and Upper Primary Scholarship Examinations in their respective divisions, except supply of question papers which is done by the School Examination Board.

7. (a) Five weeks from the date of the examinations shall be granted to examiners for submitting marks provided that when an examiner has not more than a hundred papers to examine the time allowed shall be two weeks. Marks shall be submitted in duplicate weekly in batches of 100 or so in serial order to the Registrar.

(b) Non-compliance with the rule of submission of marks within the time apportioned shall render the examiners liable to the penalty of one rupee for each day's delay in submitting the marks.

8. (a) Examiners are requested to send to this office, after the last batch of marks has been submitted, a statement showing the number of answer books they have examined of the different examinations in which they are appointed examiners. A short report on the work of the examinees should be submitted.

(b) The examiners will send all the marked answer books to the Registrar with a forwarding letter soon after the re-examination cases are disposed of by the cheapest mode of transit and submit bill of contingent charges with proper vouchers for every item in the bill.

If in case of a particular item of expenditure it is not possible to obtain a voucher, the examiner should submit a certificate in the form which will be supplied from this office on requisition.

Each examiner should submit only one such bill including all his expenditure.

9. The statement and report mentioned in 11(a) and the bill of contingent charges in 11(b) should be sent in a separate cover and not in the same cover with marks.

The said statements and reports should reach this office on or before the 20th January 1937, and the contingent bills not later than the 15th February 1937.
