NOTIFICATION

HINDU WOMEN'S TRAINING INSTITUTION, ANGUL

Applications are invited from Hindu Women candidates from Orissa seeking admission into the Hindu Women's Training Institution at Angul during the session 1944-45.

2. The course of training for the junior certificate examination for women is for two years. The lowest qualification for admission to the 1st year training class is the middle school certificate and candidates who have not passed it will be placed for a year in the preparatory class before commencement of their training. Admissions will be made from the 8th July 1944.

3. Applications for admission should be made direct to the Headmistress, Hindu Women's Training Institution at Angul so as to reach her on or before the 25th June 1944. The application should contain the following information :—

- (1) Name of candidate
- (2) Native village, Post and Home district
- (3) Present address
- (4) Age
- (5) General Education qualification

4. Copies of the following certificates should be submitted along with the application and the originals should be produced on admission to the school :—

- (1) Certificate of General Education
- (2) Certificate of conduct
- (3) Certificate of domicile if she is domiciled in the Province.

5. Candidates having physical defects or deformities (natural or acquired) are not eligible for admission.

6. Candidates below 14 years of age are not eligible for admission into the 1st Year Training Class.

7. Candidates will be required to execute a bond to serve as a teacher in a recognised school for two years after training.

8. Each stipendiary student whether in the training or in the preparatory class will receive a stipend of Rs. 14 a month if she lives in the hostel and of Rs. 11 a month if she is permitted to leave with her family.
