WANTED

(1) One fully qualified nurse on Rs. 65 a month, with free quarters, uniform allowance, Rs. 56-4-0 per annum, dhoby allowance, Rs. 2-10-0 a month and a mess allowance, Rs. 17-8-0 for an Indian nurse and Rs. 21-14-0 for an Anglo-Indian or European nurse per mensem. Age must not exceed 35 years.

(2) Two clerks on Rs. 30 a month each for Berhampur Civil Surgeon's office. Must be at least Matriculates with typewriting qualifications. Previous office experience preferred. Age below 25 years.

(3) Six qualified midwives on Rs. 30 a month each, with house-rent allowance not exceeding 10 per cent of pay, dhoby allowance, Rs. 1-12-0 per mensem and uniform allowance of Rs. 22-8-0 per annum. (4) Twenty-three compounders on Rs. 20 a month each. Must have passed IV form (Middle English Standard), possess a diploma in practical dispensing for compounders including First Aid, be able to read and write Oriya. Age should not exceed 25 years.

Pay and allowances given in all cases as above are provisional to be replaced by the scales to be finally fixed by Government.

None need apply who is not an Oriya or a person domiciled in the province of Orissa, the latter to produce domicile certificates from the District Magistrates concerned.
