DEPARTMENT OF SUPPLY AND TRANSPORT NOTIFICATIONS

The 16th August 1944

No. 14348-S.T.—The following notifications, issued by the Government of India in the Department of Industries and Civil Supplies, are republished for general information.

Bombay, 12th July 1944

No. 1/2(58)/44-CG(CS).—In pursuance of section 9 of the Hoarding and Profiteering Prevention Ordinance, 1943 (Ordinance No. XXXV of 1943), I hereby authorise all manufacturers, accredited distributing agents or dealers in "Indian Malt Whisky"—

- (a) to refuse to sell Indian Malt Whisky to any person who is not one of their old and genuine customers;
- (b) to refuse to sell Indian Malt Whisky to any person, so long as they have not met the rationed demand of their old and regular customers and for the purpose of meeting such rationed demand they shall divide the stocks in their possession at any given time into tweleve equal weekly lots and any surplus remaining in any week after meeting the rationed demand of the old and regular customers shall be made available to other genuine customers in quantities not exceeding a bottle at a time; and
- (c) to refuse to sell to any person who does not offer in exchange an equivalent number of empty bottles of a type similar to those in which the Indian-made foreign spirits to be sold are bottled.

Bombay, 12th July 1944

No. 1/2(72)/44-CG(CS).—Whereas it has been represented to me by dealers in imported Electro Depositing Materials and Equipment that the addition to landed cost allowed by the normal trade practice in force on the 31st August 1939 exceeded 20 per cent thereof:

It is hereby notified for public information that, in accordance with the proviso to sub-section (2) of section 6 of the Hoarding and Profiteering Prevention Ordinance, 1943 (Ordinance No. XXXV of 1943) and with reference to clause (b) of the said sub-section, I have sanctioned an addition of 33\frac{1}{3} per cent to landed cost of the following Electro Depositing Materials and Equipment:—

- (1) All types of polishing bobs, brushes and mops
- (2) All classes of polishing compositions
- (3) All types of scratch brushes
- (4) All types of plating salts, including salts for plating of Nickel, Tin, Zinc, Copper, Chromium and Cadmium.

Bombay, 22nd July 1944

No. 1/2(28)/44-CG(CS).—In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 11 of the Hoarding and Profiteering Prevention Ordinance, 1943 (No. XXXV of 1943) and in supersession of this Office notification No. 1/2(28)/44-CG(CS), dated the 4th April 1944, I hereby direct all producers of and dealers in electric bulbs, to mark electric bulbs exposed or intended for sale with the sale

prices, or where the marking is not feasible, to exhibit on the premises a price-list showing correct controlled selling prices as fixed by the Central Government under the Department of Industries and Civil Supplies notification No. 1/2(27)/44-CG(CS), dated the 22nd July 1944, within 7 days of the publication of this order in the official Gazette, subject to the following conditions:—

- (1) Prices once marked shall not be raised except with the previous consent of the Controller-General of Civil Supplies.
- (2) No sale shall be refused, if a purchaser is willing to purchase an article at the price marked, unless the dealer has good reasons to believe that the purchaser is wanting to purchase the article for sale; or unless the quantity demanded is in excess of that to which the purchaser is entitled in accordance with any quota or ration which may have been fixed by the appropriate Government authority in respect of that article.
- (3) The prices will be marked in blue-black ink if the article is of Indian manufacture, and in red ink if the article is of foreign manufacture.
- (4) This order shall be displayed in a prominent place in the shop.
- (5) Producers shall print the retail selling price on the carton in respect of all bulbs leaving their godowns on or after the 1st September 1944.

No. 1/2(67)/44-CG(CS).—In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 11 of the Hoarding and Profiteering Prevention Ordinance, 1943 (Ordinance Ordinance, 1943 No. XXXV of 1943), I call upon all dealers in Toilet articles, wholesalers and retailers, to exhibit a price-list at a prominent place in the shop showing clearly the wholesale and retail selling prices as fixed by the Central Government under notification No. 1/2(66)/44-CG(CS), dated the 22nd July 1944, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Prices shall be written legibly in English or the local language of the district; and
- (2) The price-list will be shown to any purchaser who makes enquiry about the correct selling prices.

No. 1/2(71)/44-CG(CS).—In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 11 of the Hoarding and Profiteering Prevention Ordinance, 1943 (Ordinance No. XXXV of 1943), I call upon all dealers in 'European Ordinance, types of vegetable seeds acclimatised in India', to exhibit a price-list at a prominent place in the shop showing clearly the retail selling prices as fixed by the Central Government under Department of Industries and Civil Supplies notification No. 1/2(70)/44-CG(CS), dated the 22nd July 1944, subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) Prices shall be written legibly in English or in the local language of the district; and
- (2) The price-list will be shown to any purchaser who makes enquiry about the correct selling prices.

PRESS NOTE PAPER CONTROL ORDER Concessions to Manufacturers of Drugs and

MEDICINES
New Delhi, 29th July 1944

The Government of India have decided to allow the following relaxations of the provisions of the Paper Control (Economy) Order, 1944, in so far as they are applicable to manufacturers of drugs and medicines:—

(1) Manufacturers of drugs and medicines may gratuitously distribute advertising pamphlets, circulars, etc., printed before the 12th June 1944, provided not more than 50 lbs. by weight of such circulars are distributed in any month and provided further that the total stock of such circulars, etc., is declared to the Paper Controller, India, 7, Royal Exchange Place, Calcutta and it is stated by which date the stock is expected to be exhausted.

(2) Manufacturers of drugs and medicines may print and distribute leaflets giving information relating to composition, dosage, etc., of medicines, provided the leaflet consists of a single sheet not exceeding 7½"×5" and provided the leaflets are distributed only to doctors on their request.

(3) For any leaflet exceeding the size specified above, special permission should be secured after satisfying the Government of India that its distribution is essential and after furnishing particulars relating to their number of pages, number of copies to be distributed and the quantity of paper to be consumed.

(4) Enclosures giving information relating to dosage, etc., should be packed with medicines only where necessary and should not exceed a single sheet of 33" > 5"

and should not exceed a single sheet of $3\frac{3}{4}" \times 5"$.

(5) Cartons for glass containers may be used. Imported medicines may be sold in the packing in which they are imported.

(6) Packing of parcels of medicines and drugs in paper and board is permitted, provided the minimum amount of paper and board is used and provided the parcels are to be sent by post or rail. For delivery within the same town packing of parcels of medicines and drugs in paper and board is not permitted.

(7) Labels exceeding 16 square inches in area printed before the 12th June 1944 may be used, provided the stock is declared to the Paper Controller, India, 7 Royal Exchange Place, Calcutta and the date by which labels of such sizes are expected to be exhausted, is communicated

to him.

PRESS NOTE

PAPER CONTROL (ECONOMY) ORDER, 1944 RELAXATIONS APPLICABLE TO MANUFACTURERS OF BIDIS New Delhi, 4th August 1944

The Government of India have decided to permit under the provisions of the Paper Control (Economy) Order, 1944. the use of labels on packets of bidis and the packing and wrapping of bidis in paper subject to the following conditions:-

(1) Packets of 25 bidis may be wrapped in a single sheet of tissue paper provided the size of the sheet does

not exceed 20 square inches.

(2) 2) packets of 25 bidis each may be packed in a single sheet of kraft paper or other packing paper not exceeding 216 square inches in area subject to the condition that each manufacturer makes it a condition of supply of bidis to his distributors that at least 50 per cent of these sheets are returned before fresh supplies are made. The returned sheets, shall be re-used by the bidi manufacturers for packing fresh supplies of bids if they are not so damaged as to be unsuitable for this purp se.

(3) That on a packet of 25 bids, if wrapped in tissue paper a label not exceeding the size $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{4}''$ shall be used.

(4) That on packets of 25 bidis not wrapped in tissue paper bandroll labels not exceeding 16 square inches shall be used.

(5) Each manufacturer of bidis can use paper for the printing of labels or bandrolls up to 50 per cent by weight of the weight of paper consumed by him in 1943.
