ELEVENTH CONVOCATION, DECEMBER 1937.

The eleventh convocation for conferring degrees and titles will be held at Walthir in the University grounds on Thur.day, 2nd December 1937 at 3 p. m.

Applications from candidates for degrees or titles in the prescribed form should be made so as to reach the Registrar not later than Monday, the 15th November 1937. I'rinted forms of application for the purpose can be obtained from the University office on application made in person or by post. Special forms of applications are available for candidates taking their degrees in absentia. Candidates should state, when writing for the forms, whether they wish to take the degrees in person or in absentia at the convocation. their applications in the office of the Registrar will not receive attention; but applications accompanied by addressed postcards will be acknowledged by the return of the latter with the University stamp duly impressed thereon.

Cards of admission to the convocation will be issued on Thursday, 25th November, to the address given in the application form. Candidates should give clearly the address to which these should be sent. Candidates for degrees or titles who do not receive cards of admission in time after the above date of posting are requested to communicate the fact promptly to the Registrar and to take a duplicate card of admission in person at the office of the Registrar a day before the date of convocation. No candidate will be admitted into the convocation pavilion without a ticket of admission.

Candidates for degrees or titles are requested to be in the convocation pavilion not later than 2 p.m. on that day. They are required by the regulations to wear the correct gowns and hoods pertaining to their respective degrees.

Candidates, having sent their who, applications to the Registrar notifying that they would attend the convocation to take their degrees or titles, fail to appear thereat, will be charged an extra fee of Rs. 10 each when they next apply for their degrees or titles.

The following are the academic robes prescribed for the several degrees. Candidates' attention is invited to the changes incorporated therein. Candidates intending to take their degrees in person are advised to make arrangements in advance to obtain the correct academic robes.

BACHELORS of Arts or Commerce or Science or Education or Medicine :-

- (a) A gown made of black stuff cut like the Cambridge B.A. gown.
- (b) A hood made of black silk or stuff edged inside with three-inch wide lining of crimson colcur for Arts. russet brown for Commerce, white for Science, yellow (canary) for Education and pale blue (Cambridge blue) for Medcine.

MASTERS (excluding those in Surgery) of Arts or Science or Education :-

- (a) A gown made of black stuff cut like the Cambridge B.A. gown.
- (b) A hood made of black silk with full lining of crimson colour for Arts, white for Science and yellow (canary) for Education.

TH.D's in Arts or Science or Medicine :---

- (a) A black gown same as for Cambridge M.A. faced with silk of crimson colour for Arts, white for Science and pale blue (Cambridge blue) for Medicine.
- (b) A hood made of scarlet cloth with three-inch wide lining of crimson colour for Arts, white for Science and pale blue (Cambridge blue) for Medicine.

A gown similar to that for the B.A. degree made of grey stuff overlaid with shawl border in the form of an Uttariya.
