No. 7-GG.—In supersession of all previous orders on the subject, His Majesty the King Emperor has been graciously pleased to permit the title 'Honourable' to be borne during their term of office by the following officers in India:—

- (1) The Members of the Governor-General's Executive Council.
- (2) The President of the Council of State.

- (3) The President of the Indian Legislative Assembly.
- (4) The Chief Justice and Judges of the Federal Court.
- (5) The Chief Justices and Puisne Judges of the Chartered High Courts.
- (6) The Governors' Ministers in the Provinces.
- (7) Residents of the 1st class.
- (8) The Presidents of Provincial Legislative Councils.
- (9) The Speakers of Provincial Legislative Assemblies.
- (10) The Chief Judge and Judges of the Chief Court of Oudh.
- (11) The Judicial Commissioners of Sind and of the North-West Frontier Province and the Judges of their Courts.
- (12) Members of the Council of State.
