NOTICE.

1. The next Law examinations will commence from Monday, June 28, 1937 and will continue from day to day holidays excepted.

2. The prescribed application form of each candidate together with a fee of Rs. 25 must reach the Registrar on or before Saturday, June 5, 1937.

3. The supplementary Matriculation, I A., I. Sc., B. A. and B. Sc. examinations will commence from Monday, June 21, 1937 and will continue from day to day, holidays excepted.

4. The prescribed application form of each candidate together with a fee of Rs. 25 for the Matriculation, Rs. 40 for the I. A. and I. Sc. and Rs. 50 for the B. A. and B. Sc. examinations, must reach the Registrar on or before Saturday, May 29, 1937.

5. The fees as well as the application forms must reach the University office on or before the dates mentioned above. Under no circumstances can or will any candidate be admitted to the examination whose fee and form are not received by the Registrar on or before the date fixed provided that the Vice-Chancellor may in his discretion direct that a fee shall be accepted which though received

after the specified date, was despatched to the Registrar not less than three days before the specified date.

6. All letters to the Registrar must be addressed in the following way:—"The Registrar, Patna University, P.O. Bankipur".

7. Information as to the number of application forms required should be supplied to the Registrar immediately after the receipt of this notice.

8. Applications for change of centre of examination must be made separately through heads of institutions. They must reach the Registrar not later than June 5, 1937. The arrangement to be made for the identification of an applicant at the new centre must be clearly and definitely stated. If this is not done the application will be rejected. Mere mention in the examination form of a centre other than the usual centre of examination will not entitle a candidate to change his centre. Private and non-collegiate candidates will not be allowed to change their centres.

Private and non-collegiate candidates for the I.A., I.Sc., B.A. and B.Sc. examinations shall be required to appear personally before the centre superintendents, before the commencement of examination to obtain their admit cards and to be satisfactorily identified.

9. When a candidate claims that he may be permitted to appear at an examination on payment of half the prescribed fee, the claim must be supported by the University letter allowing such concession; if this is not done, full fee shall have to be paid.

10. Examination fees of school and college candidates should be sent by the Headmasters and Principals concerned either by Remittance Transfer Receipts, crossed cheques, bank drafts drawn in favour of the Registrar, Patna University, or by money order to the Imperial Bank, Patna or Cuttack, *for credit in the University Account B.* Cheques should include discount at the rate of Re. 0-4-0 per hundred. Names of examinations, the number of candidates for whom fees are remitted and the name of institution should be clearly noted on the M.O. coupon. The acknowledgment from the Bank should be forwarded to the Registrar as soon as received. Treasury chalangas will not be accepted on any account.

11. Private candidates for the Matriculation examination should forward their application forms and fees through the headmasters of schools at which they appeared at the test examination. Other private candidates may remit their fees by money order to the Registrar, Patna University, P.O. Bankipur, in time to reach him on the appointed date together with application forms. G. C. notes will not be accepted unless presented personally.

12. It may also be noted that in addition to the existing system of issuing marks to examinees, a college or school may secure the scheduled marks of all its examinees at a particular examination on payment in advance of a lump sum equal to one rupee per examinee.

NOTICE.

Candidates desiring to appear as private candidates at the Certificated Teachership Examination of Secondary Training Schools to be held in March 1937 should submit their applications for permission with a fee of Rs. 10 to the District Inspector of Schools of the district where they have been working as teachers or residing on or before the 5th February 1937.

2. Applications must be written in legible English and contain the following particulars in serial order:—

- (1) Name of the applicant.
- (2) Age on the 1st March 1937.
- (3) Name of the applicant's father.
- (4) Residence (village, post office and district).
- (5) The school where he is working as a teacher.
- (6) His first vernacular.
- (7) The language in which he will write answers in—

- (a) Principles and Methods of Teaching.
- (b) School Management and Hygiene.
- (c) Child Study.
- (d) Nature Study and General Science.
- (e) Mathematics.
- (f) History.
- (g) Geography.

- (8) Subjects selected from the Refresher Course (any two of the following):—

- (a) English.
- (b) Mathematics.
- (c) History.
- (d) Geography.

- (9) His second vernacular—

For non-Oriya students only—standard selected—Middle Vernacular or Upper Primary.

- (10) The year in which he passed the Vernacular Mastership Examination (if he is appearing for the first time at the Certificated Teachership Examination) or
- (11) the part (theoretical or practical) in which, and the number of times he failed previously at the Certificated Teachership Examination with year, centre and roll number in each case.

3. A list of these applications should be compiled in the office of the District Inspectors of Schools and the consolidated list submitted to the undersigned not later than the 15th February 1937 after which date no application will be entertained. The District Inspectors are requested to note that applications from candidates should not be forwarded to this office unless this is asked for in any particular case.

4. The District Inspectors of Schools will please see that all the particulars are correctly given and they will also remark as to the eligibility of the candidate in all cases quoting the article of the Bihar and Orissa Education Code under which the candidate is eligible to sit for the examination.

5. The District Inspectors of Schools will please submit chalans showing that the due amount of examination fee for the names sent up has been deposited in the treasury. No applicant will be allowed to sit as a private candidate unless his chalan is furnished.
