GENERAL SUMMARY.—There was no rain in the province during the week under report. The harvesting of paddy still continues in the districts of Cuttack and Puri where dalua paddy is also thriving. The pressing of sugarcane is proceeding and in district Cuttack its planting is still going on. Mustard is in flowers and pods in Cuttack and Puri districts and is being harvested in certain parts. Wheat, mung, linseed and tobacco are thriving and in district Koraput the harvesting of tobacco is proceeding. Jhain mung is being sown in district Cuttack. Supply of fodder and water is reported to be sufficient. The average price of local common rice is 18.96 seers a rupee against 19.14 seers for the preceding week in North Orissa and 13.66 seers against 13.71 seers in South Orissa. The figures for North and South Orissa for the corresponding period of last year are 15.38 and 11.56 seers a rupee respectively. Cattle disease is reported from parts of Puri and Sambalpur districts.
