CUTTACK TRAINING COLLEGE.

SESSION 1936-37.

Applications are invited from candidates for admission into the Cuttack Training College for the session 1936-37.

2. The college prepares students for the Diploma-in-Education Examination of the Patna University. A degree of an Indian or any other recognised university is the minimum entrance qualification.

3. Number of admissions is limited to 22. Of these, 2 will be from the Orissa States on the nomination of the Educational Adviser, Eastern States Agency. All applicants must be natives of, or domiciled in, Orissa. Ten will receive stipends of Rs. 20 a month each. Each of the other 10 non-stipendiaries will be provided with a set of text-books not exceeding Rs. 50 in value, which must be returned to the College in good condition, at the end of the session.

4. All applicants shall be required to take a qualifying examination which will be held in the College on the 1st July at 11 A.M. No admission will be made without a personal interview. Applications from such candidates as are over 31 years may not be considered. Each applicant must deposit Rs. 5 being caution money and annas four towards charges, etc., for the entrance examination and obtain from the College office in lieu of the payment of Rs. 5-4-0 his Admit Card. No candidate will be allowed to sit for the examination unless he has shown his Admit Card to the presiding officer. In their own interests, candidates are warned to be in possession of Admit Cards before the date of the examination. The caution money will be forfeited if a candidate fails to join after admission or withdraws at any time during the session. The money will be refunded in case admission is not granted and in case of those who are admitted, at the end of the session. A candidate claiming domicile in Orissa, must submit copy of his certificate of domicile along with his application and on admission the original. Degree certificates must be produced by all candidates for inspection by the Principal when required.

5. If a candidate does not join within a week of his being informed that he has been accepted, his admission will be cancelled and his caution money forfeited.

6. Each selected stipendiary candidate will be required to enter into an agreement in the prescribed form, binding him to complete the course of training to the satisfaction of the Principal and thereafter to serve either as a teacher in a Government school or as a Sub-Inspector of schools. If he withdraws before completing the course, he will have to refund the stipend drawn by him.

7. Such candidates as do not belong to the University of Patna and graduated from any other university, must also pay at the time of admission, the registration and migration fees levied by and payable to both the universities.

8. All college charges must be paid at the time of admission, viz. the game fee and the common room fee which are respectively Rs. 3 and Rs. 2 for the session.

The new academical year of the Orissa Medical School commences on the 1st July 1936.

Candidates for admission must apply to the undersigned not later than the 15th May 1936. All such applications should be submitted in the prescribed form as per specimen given below. They should also submit the following documents, in original, along with the application forms in absence of which their applications cannot be considered :—

1. Certificate of having passed the Matriculation Examination or any higher examination. If the certificate has not been received from the University on the date of the application a certificate from the Headmaster of the School or Principal of the College, as the case may be, stating the Division in which they passed the examination will be accepted.

2. Certificate of moral character and respectability from a Government servant not below the rank of Deputy Magistrate serving in the district in which the candidate ordinarily resides or some other authority whom the committee may deem satisfactory.

A certificate of character from the Principal or Headmaster of the school in which the candidate has last studied.

3. A candidate claiming domicile in Orissa must submit a statement along with his application showing in what place and in what district he claims to be domiciled and any argument in favour of his claims he may care to produce. If he has already obtained a domicile certificate from the District Magistrate then he may forward the same in original.
