No. 218-OR./39.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (4) of section 2 of the Defence of India Ordinance, 1939, the Central Government is pleased to direct that the following amendments shall be made in the Defence Co-ordination Department Notification No. 218-OR, dated 8th September 1939, namely:—

In column 2 of the Schedule annexed to the said Notification,

- (1) for the words "General Officers Commanding. Districts," the words

"Commanders, Districts," shall be substituted;

- (2) after the words "Commanders, Brigade Areas." the words "Commanders, Brigades." shall be inserted;

- (3) for the words "Air Officers Commanding, Air Forces in India," the words "Air Officer Commanding, Air Forces in India," shall be substituted;

- (4) for the words "General Officer Commanding, Deccan District," the words "Commander, Deccan District." shall be substituted.
