NOTIFICATIONS.

The 23rd December 1936.

No. 8346—La-82-R.—Whereas it appears to the Government that the land specified in the schedule below and situated in the Vikrampuram village, Gunupur taluk, Koraput district, is needed for a public purpose, to wit, for the construction of a rest-house at Vikrampuram, notice to that effect is hereby given to all whom it may concern in accordance with the provisions of section 4 (1) of the Land Acquisition Act I of 1894 as amended by the Land Acquisition Amendment Act XXXVIII of 1923; and, the Governor of Orissa hereby authorizes the Deputy Tahsildar, Gunupur, his staff and workmen to exercise the powers conferred by

section 4 (2) of the Act. Under section 3 (c) of the same Act the Governor of Orissa appoints the Deputy Tahsildar, Gunupur, to perform the functions of a Collector under section 5-A of the Act.

No. 8647—La-81-R.—Whereas it appears to the Government of Orissa that land is required to be taken by Government at the public expense for a public purpose, viz., for retired line in the 3rd quarter of the 8th mile of Daya left embankment no. 28-B at Atharabhad and Ujanipara, in the villages of Atharabhad and Ujanipara, pargana Kotrahang, zila Puri, it is hereby notified that for the above purpose 4 pieces of land measuring, more or less, 2.11 acres, bounded on the—

Objections to the acquisition, if any, filed under section 5-A, by any person interested within the meaning of that section on or before the 24th January 1937, before the Collector of Puri, will be considered.
