ORISSA ACT 1 OF 2004

*THE ORISSA APPROPRIATION (No. 2) ACT, 2003

[Received the assent of the Governor on the 30th December, 2003, first published in an Extraordinary issue of the Orissa Gazette, dated the 5th January, 2004 (No. 17)]

AN ACT TO AUTHORISE PAYMENT AND APPROPRIATION OF CERTAIN FURTHER SUMS FROM AND OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE STATE OF ORISSA FOR THE SERVICES OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2003-2004

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Orissa in the Fifty-fourthYear of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Orissa Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2003

Issue of Rs. 11591,95,60,000 out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Orissa for the financial year 2003-2004. 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Orissa there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Eleven thousand five hundred ninety one crores, ninety five lakhs and sisty thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 2003-204 in respect of the services and purposes specified in column 2 of

the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Orissa by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
