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## ORISSA ACT 4 OF 1999

**\*THE ORISSA APPROPRIATION ACT, 1999**

[Received the assent of the Governor on the 26th March, 1999 first published in an extra issue of the *Orissa Gazette*, dated the 27th March 1999]

AN ACT TO AUTHORISE PAYMENT AND APPROPRIATION OF CERTAIN FURTHER SUMS FROM AND OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE STATE OF ORISSA FOR THE SERVICES OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR, 1998-99

**B**E it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Orissa in the Fiftieth Republic of India, as follows:—

**Short title.**

1. This Act may be called the Orissa Appropriation Act, 1999.

**Issue of**

Rs. 1512,51,42,000  
out of the Consolidated

Fund of Orissa for the  
Financial Year, 1998-99.

**Appropriation.**

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Orissa, the paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the amounting in the aggregate to the sum of one thousand five hundred two fifty-one lakhs and forty-two thousand rupees towards defraying the services which will come in course of payment during the Financial Year, 1998-99 of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Fund of the State of Orissa by this Act shall be appropriated for the purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
