1. Except in the case of minor forest-produce the total sale value must be paid in instalments as described below :—

- (a) Purchase price of Rs. 100 or below—
One instalment on or before 1st September 1945
- (b) Purchase price of Rs. 101 to Rs. 500—
1st instalment—50 per cent on or before 1st September 1945.
2nd instalment—50 per cent on or before 1st November 1945.
- (c) Purchase price of Rs. 501 to Rs. 1,500—
1st instalment—33½ per cent on or before 1st September 1945.
2nd instalment—33½ per cent on or before 1st November 1945.
3rd instalment—33½ per cent on or before 1st January 1946.
- (d) Purchase price above Rs. 1,500—
1st instalment—25 per cent on or before 1st September 1945.
2nd instalment—25 per cent on or before 1st November 1945.
3rd instalment—25 per cent on or before 1st January 1946.
4th instalment—25 per cent on or before 1st March 1946.

2. The Divisional Forest Officer, Puri Division, reserves the right to alter the date of payment of any instalment of any lot before the execution of the agreement.

3. In the case of minor produce excluding bamboos if the sale value does not exceed Rs. 500 payment shall be in one instalment as in (a) above. If above Rs. 500 then in two equal instalments, 1st as in (a) above and the 2nd on the 1st December 1945.

4. No extension of time for working in coppice coupes will be allowed.

5. Bamboos and canes occurring in sal regeneration and coppice coupes shall not be felled by the purchasers of these coupes

6. The purchasers of coppice coupes shall have to hand back the first section of their coupes to the Department by the end of March 1946 for plantation work and surrender all their rights to the produce of that section of the coupe from 1st April 1946.

7. The rab nursery areas in coppice coupes are excluded from the sal lots and the purchasers of these coupes shall not damage the nursery plants in any way.

8. The coupe purchasers whether new or old whose solvency is doubted by the Officer conducting the sale, will be required to pay 25 per cent security of the purchase price.

9. Intending bidders are advised to inspect the coupes before bidding for them at the auction. No complaints as regards area or quantity of produce will be entertained after sales are concluded.

10. The purchasers of coupe shall deliver from their coupes timbers for Defence Services in such quantity and time and at such places as may be required by the Divisional Forest Officer at the War Board schedule rates and only such timbers as are not required by the Divisional Forest Officer after passing will be released to them for disposal.

11. Coupe purchasers who are required to supply timbers to the Forest Department in fulfilment of War Board orders will be required to pay to the Forest Department a commission of Re. 0-1-0 in the rupee on the War Board price rates which amount will be realised by deduction from their dues.

12. Coupe purchasers shall have to supply such timbers as may be required by the various departments of the Government of Orissa and other private concern, engaged in production of war materials, at price rates not below those laid down in the Government of India, Supply Department schedule of rates current at the time as may be fixed by the Conservator of Forests, Orissa, less Re. 0-1-0 commission in the rupee of the Forest Department.

13. The purchasers of Kuhuri, Panigirh and Dalijora coppice coupes will not be compelled to clear the inaccessible hill top area, nor will they be allowed to do selection fellings.
