Part II

1. The purchasers must fell *Salia* and *Daba* bamboos in all coppice coupes and coupe No. 5 of the three felling series of the Uniform Working Circle.

2. It is not necessary, although provided for in the agreement conditions to clearfell the entire areas of the clearfelling and the coppice coupes and all the trees marked and numbered or only marked in the Selection and Improvement coupes except the standards marked in the clearfelling and coppice coupes. The exceptions being (i) Lankada coppice coupe No. 5 and (ii) specified sections of other clearfelling and coppice coupes where the contractor will be compelled to clearfell as indicated in the coupe tracings as will be shown in the agreement as well as on the ground. Further, it will be incumbent on the contractors to pile the debris of the clearfelling and coppice coupes of P. B. I at his own cost on such areas and in such manner as will be indicated by the concerned Range Officer.

3. Contractor of Divisional lot Nos. 6 and 8 will commence felling from sections 22 and 14 respectively and continue to work through consecutive sections in the reverse order, and that of Divisional lot Nos. 7 and 9 will start felling from sections 1 to 22 and 1 to 14 respectively.

4. The purchasers will not be allowed to fell common shrubby growth, such as, *woodfordia fruticosa*, *Ixora parviflora* and others in the coppice and clear felling coupes.

5. (a) Extraction of Shiali leaves is subject to the felling rules as in force for the Kendu leaves.

(b) Extraction of Shiali fibres and Rella bark is subject to the felling rules as in force as per Schedule IV of the agreement

(c) Exploitation of broom and Chono grass is subject to the felling rules as for the Sabai grass.

6. The payment of purchase price will be made by instalments as noted below:—

Purchase price Rs. 100 or below: One instalment on or before 1st October 1943.

Purchase price above 100 to Rs. 500: Two instalments as below:—

1st instalment—50 per cent on or before 1st October 1943.

2nd instalment—50 per cent on or before 1st December 1943.

Purchase price above Rs. 500 to Rs. 2,000: Three instalments as below:—

1st instalment—33½ per cent on or before 1st October 1943.

2nd instalment—33½ per cent on or before 1st December 1943.

3rd instalment—33½ per cent on or before 1st February 1944.

Purchase price above Rs. 2,000—

1st instalment—25 per cent on or before 1st October 1943.

2nd instalment—25 per cent on or before 15th December 1943.

3rd Instalment—25 per cent on or before 1st February 1944.

4th instalment—25 per cent on or before 15th April 1944.

7. For bamboo coupes no extension of time will be granted in any circumstances, for other coupes question of extension will be considered only on very exceptional circumstances on payment of extension fees.

8. The purchasers will be required to produce sleepers for Indian Railway requirements from all sound sal trees suitable for producing sleepers on requisition by the District Forest Officer, Ghumsur North Division.

9. All coupe purchasers shall be bound to offer back the whole outturn of their coupes to the District Forest Officer, Ghumsur North Division for passing and repurchase at Schedule rates at such railway stations or depots as to be directed by the District Forest Officer, Ghumsur North Division and that only timber not required by the District Forest Officer, Ghumsur North Division after passing will be released to the contractors for disposal by them as they like. The details of the sizes and kind of timber to be produced can be obtained from the office of the undersigned.

10. For all contractors' supplies, i.e., supplies to be made by the contractors from their purchased coupes in fulfilment of war supply orders, a commission of Rs. 0-1-0 on the rupee on the Supply Department's price rates will be charged and realised by deduction from the bills presented by the contractors for such supplies.

11. The purchasers are strictly warned to inspect the coupes beforehand. No complaints as regards the coupe areas or the growth will be entertained when the bid is accepted.

12. Purchasers of coupes will be required to pay the 1st instalment before commencing work, subsequent instalments may be adjusted on delivery of timber against Supply Department and Sleeper orders at the discretion of the District Forest Officer, Ghumsur North Division.
