SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR SALE, PURI DIVISION

Part II

- 1. The dates for the payment of the first, second and third instalments as given in the General Conditions of Sales (Part III) are altered to 25th April, 25th May and 25th November respectively.
- 2. When a purchaser buys three or more lots a codicil will be added to each agreement for each lot amalgamating the lots into one lot and the instalments into one set of instalments. Each lot will then be treated as a section for purposes of control. No such arrangement will be made if a purchaser buys only 2 (two) lots. This arrangement does not alter the rules that the purchaser must sign the agreement for any lot on the fall of the hammer at the sale and deposit the amounts of security for each lot.
- 3. Lots 1, 3, 6, 7 and 8 contain a large number of departmental sample plots in which the trees have been excluded from the list of trees, as they will be felled and measured departmentally.

- 4. The trees listed and offered for sale have been marked by the Forest Department hammer ground level. No unmarked trees will be felled and
- 5. The Divisional Forest Officer, Puri Division, reserves the right to alter the dates of payment of any instalment of any coupe, before the execution of agreement.
 - 6. No extension of time will be given.
- 7. The following ballies shall be supplied from the sale lots for war purposes. The quantity of ballies to be supplied from each sale lot will be allotted by the Divisional Forest Officer at the auction :-

Ballies—3" to 4½" mid Rs. 70 per 100 ballion diameter and 10' to F. O. R. Puri Railway under 12' long. Station including the cost

of loading in the Railway wagons.

Ballies-3" to 41" mid diameter and 12' to 18' long.

Rs. 75 per 100 ballica F. O. R. Puri Railway Station including the cost of loading in the Railway wagons.
