Applications are invited for admission to the Madras and Bihar Veterinary Colleges,

Up to three seats in the former for the B.V.Sc. degree course and four seats in the latter for Diploma course are being reserved. The candidate selected for admission to the degree course will be awarded by Government a stipend of Rs. 40 plus a temporary additional stipend of Rs. 5 a month. Three of the candidates selected for admission to the Diploma course will be awarded by Government a stipend of Rs. 20 each plus a temporary additional stipend of Rs. 4 a month and the fourth will be a non-stipendiary.
