Applications are invited from candidates who have passed at least the Matriculation or the S.S.L.C. examination for undergoing a course of training in Physical Education preferably in the Y.M.C.A. AGRICULTURAL TRAINING

Applications are invited from candidates for the training of 50 sub-overseers and 10 fieldmen. All the sub-overseers and 50 fieldmen will be trained at the Cuttack Farm and the remaining fieldmen will be trained at Sambalpur, Balia, Kujang and Khurda Farms and at Berhampur Rice Research Station.

Duration of training—One year for the sub-overseers and six months for the fieldmen. The training will commence in July 1945.

Minimum qualification for admission—(a) Matriculation or S. S. L. C. for sub-overseer training. Candidates must have agricultural bias.

(b) Candidates for the fieldman training must have passed the Middle English or Middle Vernacular examination. Good physique and capacity for hard work are essential. Applications of candidates belonging to the agriculturist class will be specially considered. Persons working as fieldmen may apply for training if they so wish. Candidates for both the courses must be above 17 and below 22 years, on the 1st July 1945.

A stipend of Rs. 20 per month to each sub-overseer student and Rs. 10 per month to each fieldman student will be awarded.
