JOINT PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

Applications are invited for a temporary post of Medical Officer of Health in the Orissa Public Health Service on a scale of pay of Rs. 180—10—300—20/2—360 a month plus a compensatory allowance in the scale of Rs. 40—4—100 a month. The selected candidate will be debarred from private practice.

2. Candidates must possess—

(a) a registerable medical qualification from a University in the United Kingdom or in India, and

(b) one of the following qualifications, if registerable in the United Kingdom or in Orissa under Orissa Regulation II of 1936—

(i) a diploma in Public Health or a University degree in Public Health obtained in the United Kingdom or in India or

(ii) the degree of Bachelor in Sanitary Science of the University of Madras.

3. Candidates possessing all the required qualifications should not be over 30 years of age on the 1st August 1945 otherwise they should not be over 28 years of age on the said date. Preference will be given to Oriyas or persons domiciled in Orissa.

4. Applications must be made to the Secretary, Joint Public Service Commission, P. O. Hinoo, Ranchi, in the prescribed form obtainable from the Secretary free on requisition, so as to reach him on or before the 14th July 1945. Candidates already in Government Service must apply through the Head of their Department and candidates in private employment are advised to submit a recent certificate from their present employers.

5. Applications must be accompanied by certificates and diplomas in original regarding candidates' qualifications; a statement of marks obtained at the final Medical degree or diploma examination; a certificate of character from the Principal of the Medical College from which he graduated; documentary evidence of any academic distinctions obtained during the medical curriculum; in case of a candidate domiciled in Orissa a certificate of domicile from the District Officer of the district in which he claims to be domiciled; a medical certificate in the prescribed form obtainable from the Secretary; evidence of age, which should ordinarily be the Matriculation certificate or its equivalent in original; a certificate or certificates to show the nature and extent of previous experience, if any, a treasury chalan for Rs. 5 as application fee which should be credited to the Government of Orissa under the head "XXXVI—Miscellaneous Departments—Miscellaneous—Examination Fees—Public Service Commission". No application fee would be payable if such a fee has been paid with a previous application for the same service but particulars of the occasion on which such a fee was paid must be given.

NOTE (i)—Candidates must see that they are eligible and must decide definitely to apply before depositing the fee in the treasury. Candidates who are already in Government service should make sure, before depositing the fee that their applications will be forwarded by their superior officers. The fee paid with the application will not ordinarily be refunded.

(ii) Candidates must properly arrange and attach all enclosures to their applications.
