BEVIN TRAINING SCHEME

(SCHEDULED CASTE CANDIDATES FOR TRAINING TO RECEIVE SPECIAL ATTENTION)

Wanted candidates for training in the United Kingdom under the Bevin Training Scheme (14th batch). Qualifications required: (a) Minimum of three years' practical workshop experience in Engineering Trades (Fitters, Turners and Mechanics, etc.) and (b) sufficient knowledge of English. Candidates having experience of automobile engineering or aircraft work are also required for training as Aircraft Mechanics. Those with experience in electroplating may also be required. Ex-trainees of the Technical Training Scheme who have passed the prescribed Grade III Trade Test may also apply. Scheduled caste candidates are specially wanted, and those among them who have not completed three years' practical workshop experience but will complete it within the next twelve months are also eligible. 2. Printed statements giving the description, prices and other details of the vehicles are available to the public for inspection at the offices of the A. R. P. Controllers, District Officers, offices of the Superintendents of Police and the offices of the Heads of Government Departments in the Province.

3. Persons who wish to purchase the vehicles, are requested to send their applications to the undersigned, so as to reach him not later than the 15th July 1945 intimating their choice of the particular vehicle which they intend to buy. In the case of L/I. vehicles (Part II of the printed List), however, applications for their purchase will be registered but the offers will not be accepted until the

receipt of orders of the Government of India to whom a reference has been made. It is requested that every applicant should give two alternative choices. Previous applications, if any, made in this connection to the Home (C.D) Department should be treated as cancelled. Applications received later than the 15th July 1945 will not be considered.

4. Preference in the sale of the vehicles will be given in the order of the following priority:—

(a) Essential users, (b) Previous owners and users, and (c) Other persons.

Applicants, who wish to be treated as 'Essential users' should get their applications endorsed by the District Magistrate of their district. In the absence of such an endorsement, their applications will be treated as applications from 'other persons' falling under category (c) mentioned above.

5. If there are more applications than one for the same vehicle, Government will decide as to the individual to whom the vehicle should be sold.

6. Applicants who will be permitted to purchase a vehicle, should deposit the purchase amount in the Treasury and produce the challan before the Headquarters office of the undersigned. On receipt of challan instructions will be issued to the Central Stores, Ranihat or to the A. R. P. Controller concerned to deliver the vehicle to the purchaser.
