Special conditions of sale

Is hereby given that 338 teak trees as detailed below, have been marked for sale in the Buchundabhogra Teak Plantation Area (Comprising Tainsi Compartments 1, 4 and 5 and Kurru Compartment 1) in the Angul Forest Division. The trees will be disposed of by public auction, to be held by the undersigned in the Divisional Forest Office, at Angul, on the 4th April 1945, at 12 noon.

2. The sale is subject to (a) the special conditions as published in this notice and (b) those mentioned in the sanctioned form of Agreement and (c) in the general condition of sale (Part III). The successful bidder shall also be bound by the Orissa Forest Contract Rules.

3. The purchaser shall be bound to supply from the trees, purchased by him, all timber passed for war supply at Supply Department rates delivered at the Government of India Temporary Timber Storage Depots at Cuttack and/cr Meramandali, 10 to 15 Tons to the Public Works Department, Orissa at Johra, Cuttack and 5 tons to the Manager, M.S.M. Railway at Talcher Colliery. The specification of timbers for the above supplies and the actual price rates thereof will be intimated to the bidders at the time of the auction.

4. The amount of sale price is payable in accordance with clause 11 of the General conditions of sales (Fart 111)
