In the matter of the modification of the scheme of administration settled by the Madras Hindu Religious Edow-

ments Board in its order No. 464, dated the 27th

August 1928 for the temples of Sri Raghunath Swami

and Sri Gopinath Swami at Berhampur town, Berhampur taluk, Ganjam district

ORDER

Whereas the Tribunal is satisfied that in the interests of the better administration of the Endowments belonging to Sri Raghunath and Sri Gopinath Swami temples at Khaspa Street, Berhampur town, Ganjam district, the scheme ct administration settled by the Madras Hindu Religious Endowments Board by its order No. 464, dated the 27th August 1928, has to be modified in certain respects, it hereby approves the following modification under sections 11 and 33 (3) of the Orissa Hindu Religious Endowments Act, 1939, for said temples and their endowments:-

MODIFIED SCHEME

1. In clause (i) for the words "in a trustee......by the Board" substitute the following:—

"in one or more trustees not exceeding three in number to be appointed by the Commissioner of Endowments". 2. For clause (ii) substitute the following:—

"(a) The trustees shall meet once a month in the temple premises for passing the accounts of the previous month and for sanctioning the necessary expenditure and for transacting any other business concerning the temples.
