## JOINT PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

Applications are invited for four temporary posts of Assistant National Savings Officers in the Province of Orissa on a pay of Rs. 210 each a month plus a bonus of 1/16 per cent on the total sales of National Savings Certificates subject to a maximum of Rs. 210 per mensem. The posts are gazetted.

2. Candidates must be graduates of a recognised University and should possess administrative experience, good local knowledge of the Province and capacity to organize meetings, etc., to influence public opinion in favour of the Savings Movement sponsored by Government. They should not be over 25 years of age on the 1st December 1945, unless already in Government service. They should be able to tour for at least 20 days in a month. Preference will be given to candidates with war service who are natives of the Province or domiciled therein.

3. Applications in the prescribed form, which can be had from the undersigned on requisition, must be submitted to the Secretary, Joint Public Service Commission, P.O. Hinoo, Ranchi, so as to reach him on or before the 30th November 1945. Candidates in Government service should apply through the head of their department and those in private employment are advised to submit a recent certificate from their employers.

4. Every application must be accompanied by certificates and diplomas in original showing candidate's qualifications, character and domicile, nature and extent of administrative experience; in case of candidates not already in Government service, a medical certificate in the prescribed form, obtainable from the Secretary; evidence of age which should ordinarily be the Matriculation certificate, or its equivalent, in original; and a treasury chalan for Rs. 5 as application fee credited to the Government of Orissa under the head "XXXVI—Miscellaneous Departments—Miscellaneous—Examination Fees—Public Service Commission". The fees should not be sent by crossed Indian Postal Orders or by cross cheques on banks.

CANDIDATES ARE WARNED THAT THEIR APPLICATIONS WILL BE SUMMARILY REJECTED IF BY THE LAST DATE FOR THE RECEIPT OF APPLICATIONS THEY ARE NOT COMPLETE IN RESPECT OF ALL THE PAPERS PRESCRIBED IN THIS ADVERTISEMENT.

NOTE—Candidates must see that they are eligible and must decide definitely to apply before depositing the fee in the treasury. In no case the fee paid with the application will be refunded.
