1. Sealed tenders are invited for supply to the Government of Orissa during the year 1946-47 of (1) Drawing materials, (2) Miscellaneous stationery articles, (3) Writing inks, (4) Typewriting materials, (5) Press and Binding materials, (6) Rubber stamps and brass scals, etc. and (7) Miscellaneous articles for Press and Forms stores.

2. Articles of Indian make will be given preference in making purchase. Tenderers are requested to note against each item of articles they tender for whether it is of Indian or foreign manufacture.

3. The tenderers should quote a firm rate for the whole year and deposit carnest money amounting to five per cent of their tender value subject to a minimum of Rs. 5 for each schedule with the exception of Schedule VI-Rubber stamps and brass seals, etc., for which a fixed sum of Rs. 20 for earnest money and Rs. 40 for security deposit is required. Details of articles and tender forms can be had on application from the office of the undersigned on payment of Re. 1 each per schedule.

4. For schedules I to V and VII the rates quoted should be F. O. R., Cuttack, B.-N. Railway and for VI free delivery at all parts of the Province.

5. Samples should reach the office of the undersigned the 10th January 1946. They should be properly labelled or marked with the item number of the schedule to which they relate. Samples of different schedules should not be sent together, but packed separately for each schedule. Three copies of lists of samples, clearly type-written or printed and free from erasers or corrections, duly signed by the tenderer should be submitted-one copy with the Railway receipt, another with the tender and the third one in the cover or package containing samples. No tender will be considered unless accompanied with samples. The tenderers are requested to mention in their tender clearly whether their samples, if found unsuitable and not approved, will be returned to them at their own cost, and if so, the correct postal address or Railway Station whichever they like, should also be stated, otherwise no further claim for their unapproved samples will be entertained.

6. The tenderers must sign the tender form on page 2 and the Conditions of Contract on page 4, otherwise their tenders are liable to be rejected.
