NOTICE OF SALE OF FOREST PRODUCE IN PARLAKIMEDI FOREST DIVISION, ORISSA, 1945

Part I

List of timbers and other forest produce as listed in the attached statement for the sessions, 1945-46

To be sold by public auction at Parlakimedi District Forest Office on the 20th (Minor Forest Produce Units and Coupes of Parlakimedi Malliahs) and 21st (Minor Forest Produce Units and Coupes of Thumba Malliahs) June 1945 commencing at 1 P.M. each day.

Note—The sale of the lots listed in the attached statement is subject to the Orissa Forest Contract Rules and the special conditions published in Part II of this Notice and those mentioned in the sanctioned forms of agreements and such other conditions as may be notified at the time of auction of sale of right to exploit Minor Forest Produce in Forest Department of Orissa, Parlakimedi Division, which bidders are required to sign before bidding as a token of their having read and accepted the conditions.

2. Copies of the sanctioned forms of agreement, Orissa Forest Contract Rules and General Conditions of Sale may be seen in the office of the District Forest Officer, Parlakimedi Forest Division, between 11 A.M. and 5 P.M. on week days excepting Sundays and public holidays.

3. Intending bidders are strictly warned to inspect the areas notified in the sale list. No complaints as regards areas or growth will be entertained after the sales are concluded.

4. Government shops have been opened at Jirang and Gyba for collecting Minor Forest Produce on behalf of the contractor. The Minor Forest Produce so collected will be handed over to the contractor of the Unit on Wednesday and Saturday every week during the lease period. The contractor of the said unit is therefore required to deposit sufficient funds in advance with the District Forest Officer to enable him to purchase the Minor Forest Produce from Savaras on his behalf at rates fixed by the District Forest Officer from time to time.
