1. Except the case of minor forest-produce the total sale value must be paid in instalments as described below:—

(a) Purchase price of Rs. 100 or below—

One instalment on or before 1st August 1943

(b) Purchase price of Rs. 101 to Rs. 500—

1st instalment—50 per cent on or before 1st August 1943.

2nd instalment—50 per cent on or before 1st October 1943.

(c) Purchase price of Rs. 501 to Rs. 1,500—

1st instalment— $33\frac{1}{3}$ per cent on or before 1st August 1943.

2nd instalment— $33\frac{1}{3}$ per cent on or before 1st October 1943.

3rd instalment— $33\frac{1}{3}$ per cent on or before 1st December 1943.

(d) Purchase price above Rs. 1,500—

1st instalment—25 per cent on or before 1st August 1943.

2nd instalment—25 per cent on or before 1st October 1943.

3rd instalment—25 per cent on or before 1st December 1943.

4th instalment—25 per cent on or before 1st February 1944.

2. The Divisional Forest Officer, Puri Division, reserves the right to alter the date of payment of any instalment of any lot before the execution of the agreement.

3. In the case of minor produce excluding bamboos, if the sale value does not exceed Rs. 500 payment shall be in one instalment as in (a) above. If above Rs. 500 then in two equal instalments, 1st as in (a) above and the 2nd on the 1st December 1943.

4. No extension of time for working in coppice coupes will be allowed.

5. Bamboos in coppice coupes will be sold along with the tree species and the contractor will be compelled to clearfell all clumps in the coupe.

6. The purchasers of S. W. C. coupes and coppice coupes shall deliver from their coupes timbers for Defence Services in such quantity and time and at such places as may be required by the Divisional Forest Officer at the War Board scheduled rates and only such timbers as are not required by the Divisional Forest Officer after passing will be released to them for disposal.

7. Coupe purchasers who are required to supply timbers to the Forest Department in fulfilment of War Board orders will be required to pay to the Forest Department a commission of Re. 0-1-0 in the rupee on the War Board price rates which amount will be realised by deduction from their dues.

8. The purchasers of Kuhuri and Panchgarh coppice coupes will not be compelled to clearfell the inaccessible hill top areas. The approximate areas of such hill tops will be announced at the time of auction.

9. For further particulars a reference may be made to the Divisional Forest Officer, Puri Division, Khurda.
