Part II

1. Unless otherwise specified in Part I the payment of purchase money will be made in full or by instalments as detailed below:—

(a) Purchase price of Rs. 100 or below—

One instalment on or before 15th October 1944

(b) Purchase price of Rs. 101 to Rs. 500—

1st instalment—50 per cent on or before 15th October 1944,

2nd instalment—50 per cent on or before 15th January 1945.

(c) Purchase price above Rs. 500—

1st instalment—33½ per cent on or before 15th October 1944.

2nd instalment—33½ per cent on or before 15th January 1945.

3rd instalment—33½ per cent on or before 15th March 1945.

The District Forest Officer, Ghumsur South Division, reserves the right of altering the dates of payment of any instalment in the case of any coupe.

In case of minor forest-produce and banjars, if the annual sale value does not exceed Rs. 500, in one instalment as in (a) above. If above Rs. 500, in two equal instalments as in (b) above.

2. Debries, i.e., small wood should be piled closely between the lines pagged to a height of 2½ feet and a width of 3 feet for rab sowing before the 31st March 1945 otherwise it will be done departmentally with the produce from the leased area and the actual cost plus 25 per cent supervision charges will be realised from the purchaser.

The names of coupes in which this collection will be required to be done by the purchaser of the coupe together with the length of line over which such debries is to be collected are noted below:—

3. Regeneration coupes of P. B. I will be clear-felled excluding the standards marked for retention.

4. All *Bambusa arundinacea* (Konta banso) clumps will be clearfelled in coupes of P. B. I but the contractors are not compelled to remove the unmarketable species.

5. *Dendrocalamus strictus* (salimbo bamboos) occurring in regeneration or coppice coupes may not be clearfelled but they must be clearfelled in the following coupes by the purchasers :—

Tangari C. C. 6 (A), Sondosulia C. C. No. 6 (A) (B), Malti C. C. No. 6 (A) and Kamarsuni C. C. No. 6 (A) (B).

6. All common shrubs such as *wood-fordia fruticosa* and *Dozra parviflora*, etc., should not be felled.

7. In the selection-cum-improvement felling coupes of P. B. II, III and IV as well as such open eroded areas, if any, contained in regeneration coupes of P. B. I demarcated by a cleared cut line, all marked trees for felling will be felled. The contractors are not compelled to remove the unmarketable trees.

8. Minor Forest Produce items will be sold either in single or in group.

9. Foreign contractors and local contractors whether new or old whose solvency is doubted by the officer conducting the sale, will be required to pay 25 per cent security of the lease amounts unless they produce the solvency certificates from the Taluk Officer, in whose jurisdiction they reside.

10. For bamboo coupes no extension of time will be granted in any circumstances and for other coupes question of extension will be considered only in very exceptional circumstances on payment of extension fees.

11. No mango, tamarind or fruit-bearing trees should be left unfelled except in 40-year rotation coppice coupes, where they do not interfere with the growth of principal and secondary species.

12. Intending bidders are strictly warned to inspect the areas beforehand. No complaints as regards area or growth will be entertained after the sales are concluded.

13. The purchasers of coupe shall deliver from their coupes timbers for Defence Services in such quantity and time and at such places as may be required by the District Forest Officer at the rates to be fixed by him and only such timbers as are not required by the District Forest Officer after passing will be released to them for disposal.

The purchasers will be bound by the rules and regulations of the Supply Department in this respect. This restriction does not apply to firewood as defined in the Timber Transit Rules.

14. Coupe purchaser shall have to supply such timbers as may be required by the various departments of the Government of Orissa at price rates not below these laid down in the Government of India, Supply Department, schedule of rates current at the time as may be fixed by the Conservator of Forests, Orissa.

15. The District Forest Officer, Ghumsur South Division, has the power to terminate any contract for supply of war timbers absolutely on the expiration of the period of three months from the date on which notice of intention to terminate such contract has been served on the contractor by the District Forest Officer, Ghumsur South Division.

16. Coupe purchasers who are required to supply timbers to the Forest Department in fulfilment of war board orders will be required to pay to the Forest Department a commission of Re. 0-1-0 in the rupee on the rates fixed which amount will be realised by deduction from their dues.

17. The contractor shall at all times during the currency of this contract sell to local people for their own bona fide domestic and agricultural requirements, timber, firewood, bamboos, and M. F. P. not exceeding the maximum rates laid down in the Forest Schedule of rates for Ghumsur South Division current at the time.

18. Before any other work in the area is begun the purchasers of tree-growth on banjar shall clear lines 10 feet broad along the boundaries of the leased area to the satisfaction of the Range Officer.

19. Excepting in the case of the following coupes of 60 and 80 years' rotation felling series of P. B. I., coupe purchasers need not clearfell the unmarketable trees in very hilly and inaccessible areas :— Kerachuli C. C. 6, Vinjigiri C.C. 6 (A), Raipada C. C. 6 (A), and Hukuma C.C. 6 (A).

20. Khair (*Accasia Catechu*) trees occurring in regeneration and coppice coupes should not be felled by the contractors and they should be treated as standards.
