Part I

List of timber and other forest-produce as listed in the attached statement for season 1943-44.

To be sold by public auction, at the Divisional Forest Office, Sambalpur Division, on the 30th and 31st August 1943, at 12-30 P.M. each day.

NOTE—The sale of lots listed in the attached statement is subject to the special conditions published in Part II of this notice and those mentioned in the agreement form and in the general conditions of sale. The successful bidders shall also be bound by the Orissa Forest Contract Rules.

Part II

1. Debris, i.e., small branch wood will be collected and piled closely by coppice coupe purchasers in blank areas in lines 3 ft. wide and 3 ft. high for rab sowing at their own cost. The length of the rab line in respect of each coupe will be notified at the time of sale. The work must be done before the end of February 1944.

2. The purchaser of coppice coupes need not fell unmarketable trees in very hilly and inaccessible areas of coupe No. 23 of the following felling series in areas to be specified at the time of the sale :—

Kendrapat, Bander, Mundher, Baduapali and Jaduloisingh.

3. The purchaser of coupe No. 23 of Lachmidungri and Garmunda Felling Series will have to sell firewood from their coupes to the local villagers for their own bona fide consumption at rates not exceeding the following ;—

Fire-wood—Head-load at Re. 0-0-9, Kewar load at Re. 0-1-0, bullock cart at Re. 0-8-0 and buffalo cart at Re. 0-12-0.

4. The bamboo coupe purchasers must first meet the requirements of local populace before exporting bamboos for other purposes. The sanctioned schedule of rates, viz., Re. 0-15-0 per hundred may be charged.

5. The dates for the payment of the 2nd and 3rd instalments as given in paragraph 11 of the General Conditions of Sale (Part III) are altered to 15th December and 15th February respectively.

6. The lessee shall be bound to supply, from the trees purchased by him, all timber as may be specified by the Divisional Forest Officer to be required for war purpose. Payment for such timber will be made at rates fixed by the Supply Department, provided that the Divisional Forest Officer may require the lessee to supply such timber to the Forest Department at a rate of one anna in the rupee less than the rate fixed by the Supply Department. Only timber rejected and not required by the D. F. O. to meet war supply will be released for sale. The lessee will be bound by the rules and regulations of the Supply Department in this respect.

7. For further particulars reference may be made to the Divisional Forest Officer, Sambalpur Division, Sambalpur.
